2) Minutes of previous meeting – 19 April 2012 & Extraordinary meeting held 25 May 2012

The minutes of the meetings held on 19 April and 25 May were agreed.

3) Matters arising

19 April

i) Deputy Chair

Mr Worthington reminded members of the need to agree a deputy Chair for the meeting on 16 August. A new Chair would be required for meetings post August as Mr Worthington would be leaving the Northern Trust in August.

25 May

i) Parenting Forum

Members noted that the Forum had been renamed Parenting Reference Group, and would be taking forward one of the actions regarding disability included in the Action Plan.

ii) Ballymoney Locality Group

Information providing an update on the work of all the Locality Groups, prepared by Ms Ramsey and Ms Anderson, was distributed. Mrs Hardy advised that the launch of the Ballymoney Locality Group, on 28 June, had garnered a lot of political interest. Councillor Mervyn Storey would be speaking at the event and Mr Gilbert would represent the Northern Outcomes Group. Ms McAteer would be giving a presentation on how other locality groups operate. Ms Ramsey and Ms Anderson facilitated open events in Bushmills on 21 June.

Since their launch the Magherafelt Locality Group has established two sub groups linked to the community planning process in the Council.

There are now 20 locality sub groups across the region, the Chairs of which meet on a quarterly basis.

4) Commissioning process 2012/13

Mrs Hardy shared a discussion paper on commissioning of early intervention services 2012 and beyond. Members of the Partnership had been asked to nominate representatives to the integrated commissioning sub group. It was anticipated that guidance on long term commissioning would be provided. Following discussion it was agreed that applications for funding would be for service provision during 2012/13 and 2013/14. Mrs Hardy identified the five key areas for which services should be commissioned as follows

- mental health
- parental mental health and addiction
- ADHD
- community based services for young people at risk of offending
- disability and access to services

It was agreed Mrs Hardy, Mrs Geelan, Mr Fenton, Mrs Devlin, Ms Stephen, Mr McMillan and Mrs Dunn would meet to develop a suitable specification for consideration at the next Outcome Group meeting.
