3. CYPSP Update	Ann Hardy fed back on the Strategic Partnership, who will meet again on March 12 2012. Anne explained the topics discussed at previous meetings and that the June meeting will focus on action plans. Anne advised that it had been slow to get branding and logos developed, but that this has now been completed. A mock up of the website was circulated, which showed the information being developed, the links to statistical info and databases, information on topics such as parenting's, family support etc. There was a discussion on how partners could tie into this and have links on this site to their own. Anne explained that there would be a Face book page, but it would be fan based, as opposed to being able to make comments. Gillian Gibson, asked about the Community representatives who had stepped down from Partnership, and how new candidates would be selected. Anne advised that selection had taken place through co-option, ensuring a equitable geographical spread. Anne agreed to forward details of who had been selected The final issue discussed was how the Partnership and the outcomes groups link. This group is fortunate to have Pip Jaffa as a dual member. It was agreed that there needs to be a formal way that information is exchanged and that this is consistent across all groups. 4. Mapping Exercise	Anne Hardy described what was intended, but emphasized that she was keen not to duplicate what was already going on. Annie Armstrong, Denis Paisley, Maurice Leeson

	Anne Hardy mentioned that there would be a page on website, to capture memories and data and share good practice and learning in respect of locality planning. Ian advised the group on the work of NESTA, who deliver innovation within a community setting and said he would forward a link to their website to all members.	IS to forward link to NESTA website
	It was agreed by all that some work was required in the two council areas (Down and North Down and Ards) to identify community groups and how we could work with them on the mapping and ongoing locality planning. Ian suggested that Jason White would pull together a paper for members to populate to try and capture what was going on across the area. 	There was acceptance that regional specialty groups were in place, but that the SE Area would like to retain local sub groups, such as Disability, Family Support etc. Only issue was the support locally for these groups, HSCB do not have capacity to be able to do this.	
5. Update from Family Support	Michael Murray explained that he had carried out an analysis of activity in 2011. Packages offered 1,100 offered, 40% in Lisburn sector. 25% child care, 25% family support. Referrers are 42% Health Visitors, 16% Gateway. He also advised that an evaluation of outcomes for service users is being carried out. Work is underway to expand Family Support in Down, of those on the edge of crime. 	Maurice Leeson updated the group on the development of the Family Support Hubs and the drive to develop some level of uniformity.	

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	Key is to try and have as few meetings as possible, 0-18 age range, amalgamate two types of meetings (Child Intervention Panel and Hubs). Discussion was over skewing of resources to a particular age range, with no additional resources. This is being piloted in Down area, to see if this works. Reason for using the Down, is that they had the capacity to be able to do this.

	It was explained that the Public Health Agency have written to the Trust inviting a bid for Family Nurse Partnership funding. We will bid and our intended work will fit within the broader continuum of early intervention framework going on in the Trust.	
	Patricia Linus advised that the Big Lottery Improving Futures bid, project has been successful and that, workers will be working alongside Gateway teams at level 1 and 2, developing an early intervention project, which will be established by June 2012.	
	Anne Armstrong advised that on the 26 <sup>th</sup> March – Colin will target 5,000 house and advise people that the area is an early intervention area.
