Members of the Fermanagh Locality Planning Group took part in the celebration event setting out information stands to provide information about local services for families.

The family fun event was held at the newly opened community space in Enniskillen Castle on Tuesday 25th June for families who attend the weekly Families Together service. Families Together are a key member of the Fermanagh LPG. They provide services for families in the area in the Lakeland Forum and Westend Community Venue including play, shared parenting experience and friendship. Doreen Mullan, Centre Co-Ordinator, her project staff and band of willing volunteers arranged this event to allow families to mingle and enjoy different activities within the Castle walls. Many children found it a very exciting play space with the recent renovations for the G8 to make the space more family friendly and encouraging families to visit.

Priscilla Magee, Fermanagh Locality Planning Coordinator also initiated a local survey asking families about their experiences of the impact of the current economic climate. Results of this survey will be published later and will inform the work of the CYPSP Locality Planning Group.

This funding also provided the funding for refreshments for lots of thirsty children and a very welcome cup of tea for the grownups.
