



Stopping Domestic and Sexual Violence and Abuse in Northern Ireland 2013-2020 - A Consultation

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety and the Department of Justice launched a public consultation on the draft 'Stopping Domestic and Sexual Violence and Abuse in Northern Ireland 2013-2020' on 15 January 2014. This document proposes to have in place enhanced services, protection and support for all victims and witnesses of Domestic and Sexual Violence and Abuse, and to ensure perpetrators are called to account.

Both Departments would welcome comments on any aspect of the proposals included. The closing date for comments is **11 April 2014**. Responses received after this date will only be considered in extreme circumstances and with prior agreement from the Department.
