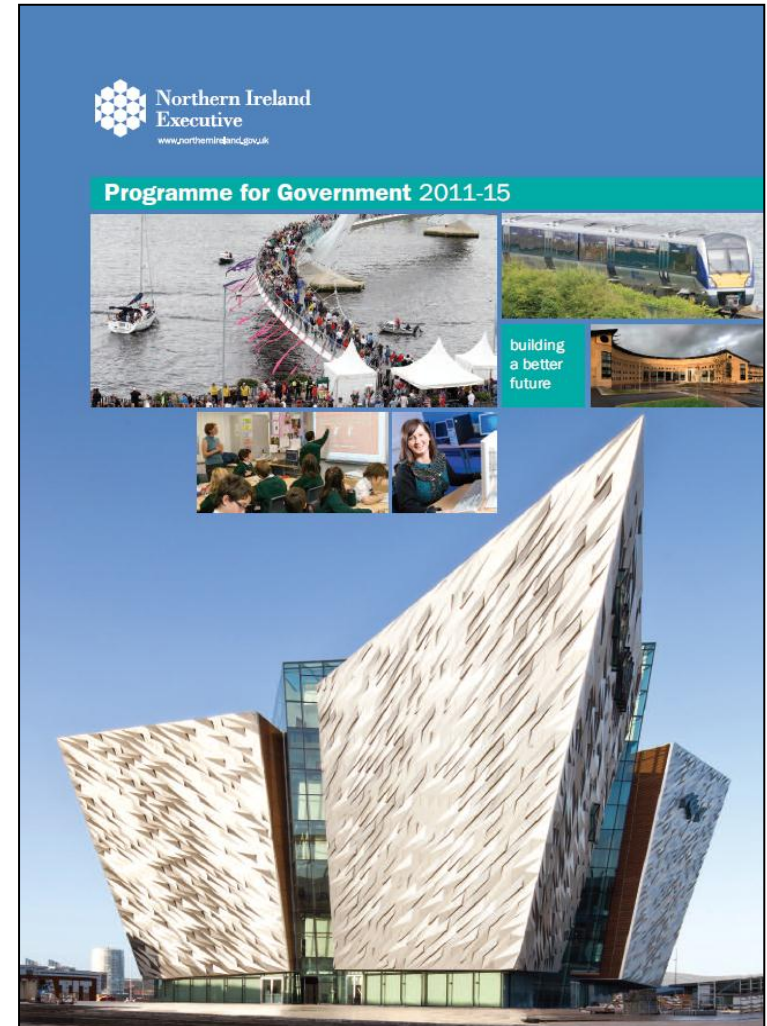
Origins of Delivering Social Change

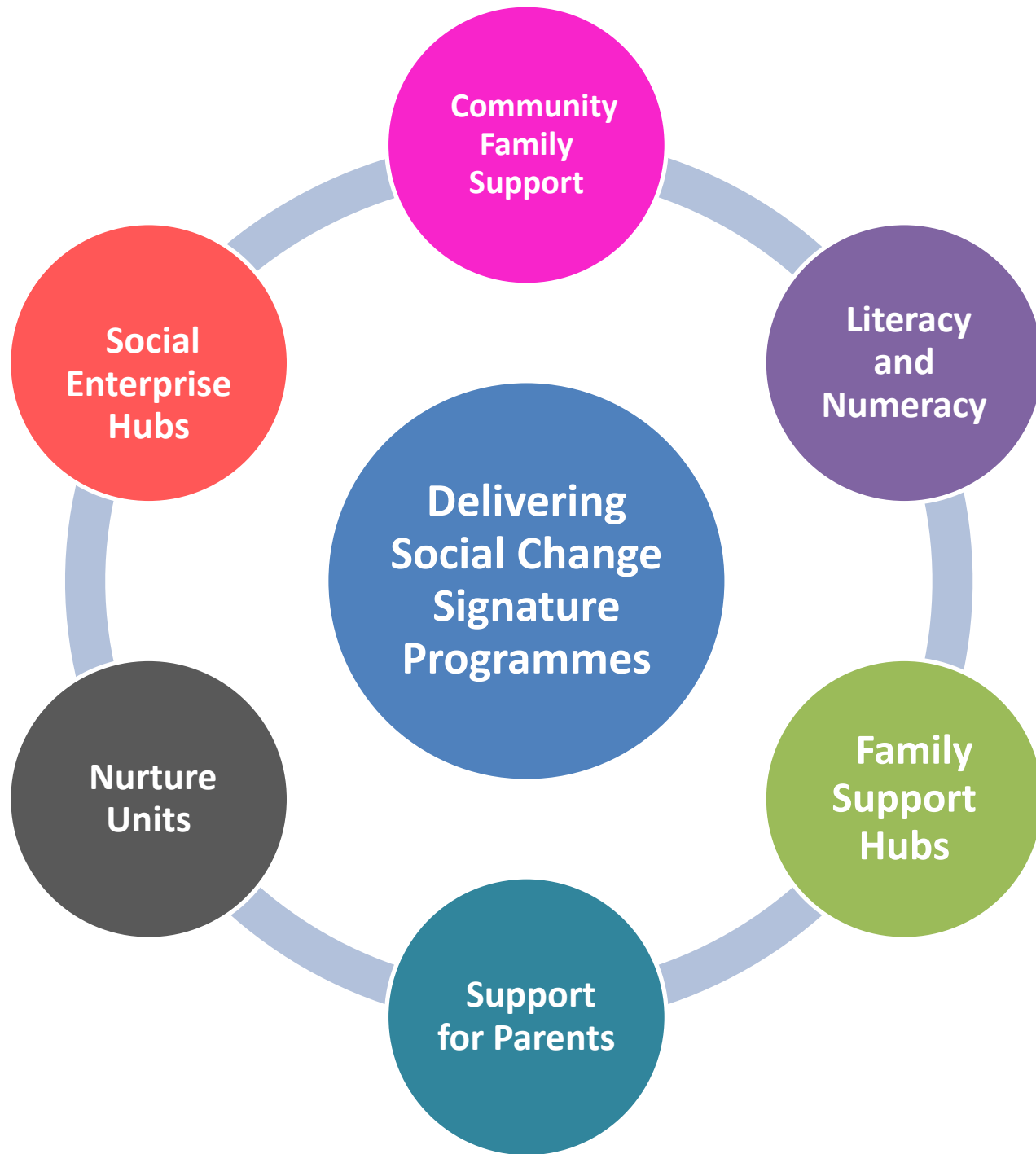
- Children and Young People's Strategic Partnership multi-agency approach
