Welcome and Introductions:

Bronagh welcomed everyone to the locality planning meeting and carried out a round of introductions. Members introduced themselves and gave a brief overview of their work and why they were attending the locality planning group

Matters Arising:

As this was the first meeting for Bronagh since she returned from maternity leave the meeting was called to touch base with members and for members to re-engage with the process. The majority of those in attendance were new to the process and therefore the majority of the meeting was spent with Bronagh detailing the CYPSP process, how it worked and the importance of local input to the process. Margaret wanted to know how the locality process worked with the family support hubs and how the 2 process were linked. Locality issues were discussed and how they were feed through to the Western outcomes group, members were interested in knowing how local issues and emerging trends were being addressed at a western level.
