The Belfast Health and Social Care Trust has been asked to coordinate a process to secure the delivery of a range of appropriate family support services on behalf of the Belfast Outcomes Group for the period 1st of May 2015 – 31st March 2016 *(with a potential extension period of up to 24 months)*

The Belfast Outcomes Group intent is to commission services which will link to the emerging network of Family Support Hubs across Belfast. All funded services will be expected to address the needs of children and young people in line with the priority areas outlined below. All services will target those families at the Hardiker tier two level of need who reside within BHSCT area.

Priority Areas

Priority1 (Child focused interventions)

To engage vulnerable school age children (4 -18 years), who are at risk of poor outcomes, with a focus on improving resiliency

Priority 2 (Family focused interventions)

To engage vulnerable families with school age children (4 – 18 years) to support the development of resiliency within those families who are at risk of poor outcomes due to pressures on family relationships.
