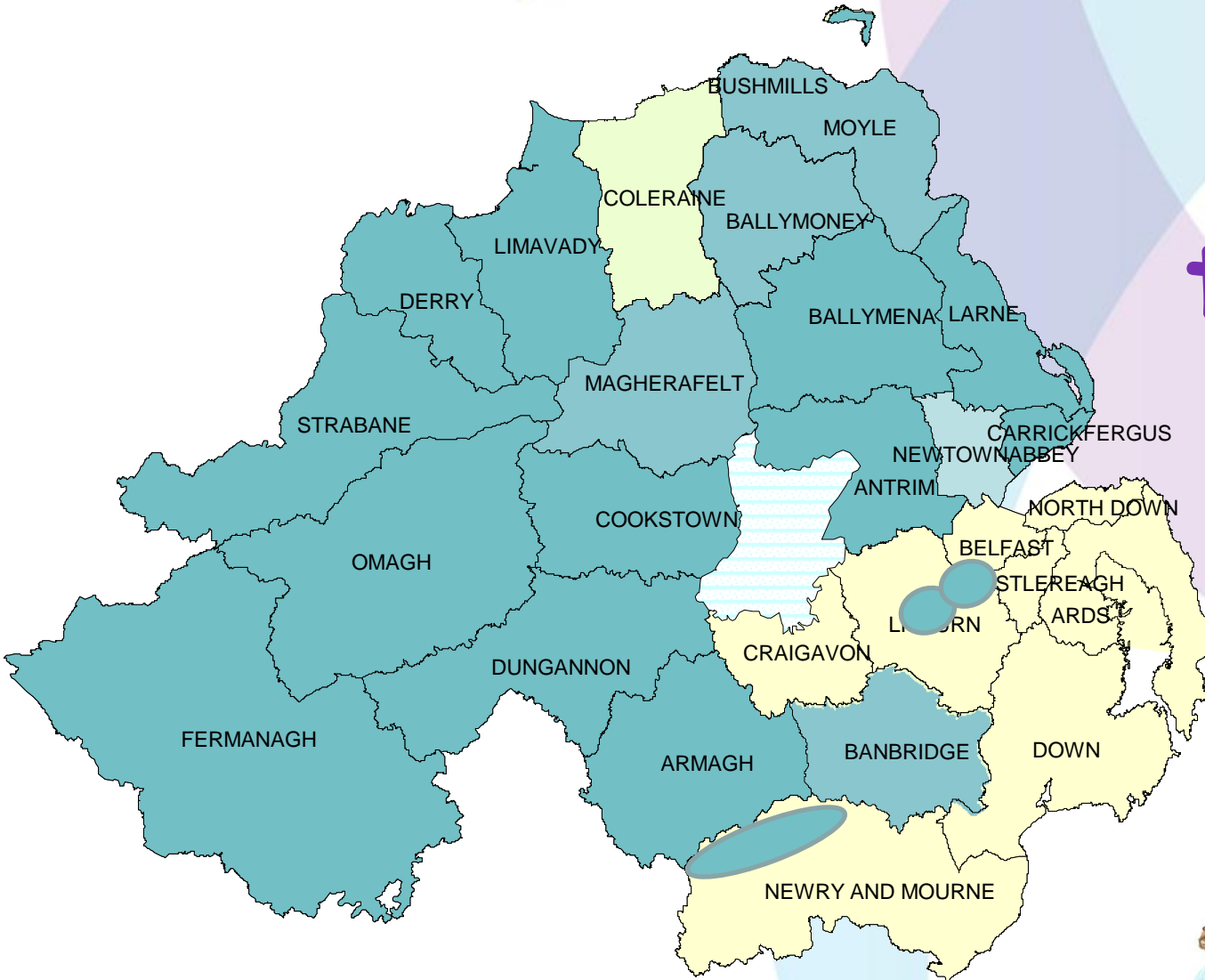

What do they do?

The role of each locality planning group is to

be a **partnership** between children and young people, families, communities and representatives of agencies at locality level at a geography that makes sense to the local community

draw up a locality **plan** to address priorities identified through **outcomes based planning** and to

mobilise local resources from the statutory, voluntary and community sectors to address these priorities – as part of the Children and Young People's Plan

Family Support Hub

A Family Support Hub is a multi-agency network of statutory, voluntary and community organisations that either **provide early intervention services** or work with families who need early intervention services.

The network **accepts referrals** of families who need early intervention family support and uses their knowledge of local service providers to signpost families with specific needs to appropriate services.
