Inreach

Cedar's Inreach Service, funded by the Belfast Health & Social Care which provides a flexible family support service to children with complex health care needs and their families. Cedar will deliver the service in partnership with the Belfast Health and Social Care Trust.

Transitions Service



Cedar's Transitions Service is an early intervention service that enables young people to make appropriate choices when moving on from school to Further or Higher Education, training or employment ensuring they achieve their maximum potential. The service not only supports the young person but also provides accurate information to parents and the key professionals who are involved to ensure a smooth transition.

Youth Matters



The Youth Matters Service provides social activities and personal development programmes for young people with disabilities up to 18 years old. Through our service we hope that young people will have improved access to inclusive and positive activities within their local area which will impact on their general health and wellbeing.
