4.0 Action Planning – Identifying and Agreeing Priorities

There was a discussion around identifying and agreeing three or four priorities that the group can take forward over the coming 12 month period and this involved examining the statistical information and stakeholder event information that was collated by Annie.

The chosen priorities for the Armagh Locality Planning Group are as follows:

- Looking at a family centred approach (importance of considering the needs, goals, and outcomes of the family as a whole; having the family at the centre of the work of the Locality Planning Group)
 - Membership of the Locality Planning Group (Pat McGeough raised concerns over the lack of representatives from community and sports groups)

encourage representation of Community groups again as well as Sports groups.

Information Road Shows

Working through the local schools to deliver a series of road-shows (Keady town, the surrounding rural areas and Armagh city). These could take the form of information events to highlight and promote the services that are available for families in the local area. It was stressed that Mount St Catherine's Primary School is very proactive and engages well with activities and external groups.

5.0 Appointment of Vice-Chair

Mia Murray was today nominated (by Colleen at ATSG) to be Vice-Chair of Armagh Locality Planning Group.

6.0 Member Agency Update

Jacqueline Connolly announced that a Bulgarian group has been established. This will offer the opportunity to all families/people in general to learn the Bulgarian language.

Big Lottery Bid – Telephone interview was undertaken and currently awaiting a decision on this.

Ciara Burke announced that there is a Small Grants Scheme available for voluntary and community sector organisations. This non-recurring funding aims to address the themes of Mental Health & Emotional Well-Being, Suicide Prevention and Self- Harm. This grant is being administered by the Clear Project.

Mia Murray announced that Arke Sure Start's new website has just recently been launched.

Furthermore, Mia discussed "In Kind Direct" where the staff redistribute products from companies to charities, social enterprises and not-for-profit organisations. End of line products are available at this site also.

It was suggested that the Coordinator of the Armagh Foodbank (which is organised by the Trussell Trust) be invited to be a member of Armagh LPG and to promote the work that is done.

Joanne McCourt currently looking at alternative funding options to meet demand. Joanne spoke about PHA funded project which offers 'Starter Pack' for homeless households leaving temporary accommodation to take up their own tenancies. No criteria necessary and there are a list of areas in which the packs can be collected.

The LPG members agreed to drop "City" from the group's name – new name: "Armagh Locality Planning Group" – to reflect work that is being done in the wider area.
