WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Brenda welcomed everyone to the meeting today and a round of introductions took place.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

KARINA MCCOLLUM – CAUSEWAY COAST AND GLENS COUNCIL

Karina introduced herself as one of the new Community Planning Officers in Causeway Coast and Glens Council area. She explained that for legislation the term community means the whole area and planning will take place over 10-15 years.

Community Planning partners include:

- Western Health and Social Care Trust (WHST) - Education Authority NI
- Health and Social Care Board (HSCB) - Tourism NI
- Public Health Authority (PHA) - Housing Executive
- Northern Ireland Fire & Rescue Service (NIFRS) - Council for Catholic Maintained Schools (CCMS)
- Northern Health & Social Care Trust (NHSCT) - Invest NI
- Police Service of Northern Ireland (PSNI) - Sport NI
- Causeway Coast And Glens Borough Council - Libraries NI

Karina spoke on community involvement and noted The Local Government Act (NI) 2014 requires Council and its Community Planning partners to seek the views of the community, encourage communities to express their views and take those views into account. A Public Engagement Event will take place to allow everyone to input and have their say. For those not able to make meetings there is a questionnaire available online. If you would like to be kept updated there is also a form to complete.

Selena agreed to circulate presentation following today's meeting and Brenda thanked Karina for attending.

FEEDBACK– OUTDOOR ACTIVITY SESSION

To date the outdoor activity session has not been popular. Phoenix ADHD has requested that they use the money to fund an OCN course.

UPDATE – JOINT EVENT EA YOUTH SERVICE / LPG

Selena provided background information and updates from the previous meeting. Further planning is being completed in order to organise this event. Once a date is confirmed Selena will provide updates.

UPDATE – BUSHMILLS EDUCATION PROJECT

Selena provided background information on the Bushmills Education Project. The group are meeting regularly and have a 2 year plan focusing on reading. The project are tackling reading in the whole community and offering support. There will be a Book Library, Book Bug, books going around schools and a social media book with the idea of the book travelling around the world.

Agencies are providing incentives throughout the project to encourage more reading. Surestart have a big bug. Discussions took place around the potential link through PeoplePlus NI as education for parents.

UPDATE - BELIEVE IN YOUTH, IMPACT OF ALCOHOL

The Believe in Youth Project are fully booked to deliver 'Fun with Mocktails' across the Northern Trust area over the summer months. These will be encouraging fun without alcohol as well as raising awareness of the impact of alcohol misuse.

Schools previously visited have also requested more awareness programs for new students running from September through to October.

UPDATE – FAMILY SUPPORT HUBS

Phil Joyce has taken over from Clare McKay as the new Service Coordinator and has funding now until March 2017. Sharon noted there were 35+ referrals at the last Family Support Hub with a clear gap for 5-8 year olds.

MEMBER UPDATES

Michelle Maguire – EA NI Youth Service

Clare Mangan has now taken over as Director of Children & Young People's Services and at present decisions are being made slowly as management is being embedded. Shaun and Tracey have forwarded a lot of data regarding mental health to try to ensure rural communities are still considered in light of regional changes.

Sharon Kirk – Dalraida Rural Surestart

Parenting programme is coming to an end. A number of things are planned over the summer including Train/ Beach / Olympics Fun Day. Baby Massage and Yoga continue over the summer.

Clare McKay – NICMA

Core training will be completed by the end of June and no training will be offered during the summer. Pre-registration seminar is organised in Ballymena and joining areas as numbers are quite low. Clare is keen to link with any activities over the summer.

Amy Selby – Start360

Amy noted N-NAGE have the capacity to outreach in Ballycastle. The One Stop Shop will be celebrating their Second birthday on 5th August and will have an open party. Young People have completed Singer/Song Writing which included production of CD's. There is also a sexual health clinic available to young people and free condoms.

Wendy Burgees – Start360

DACT have agreed priorities:

- Workplace awareness of alcohol and other substances
- Raising awareness of those at risk of isolation
- Sporting Groups – performance enhancing drugs
- LBGT – Rainbow / Cara Friend
- Young People and further education

Linda Guy - Network Personnel

A waiting list has been created and uptake has been good. Linda has visited local Schools to give information on the Community Family Support Programme. They are now able to offer support to anyone 16+ and NEET.

People Plus NI

Information was provided on the number of courses currently running. Food Hygiene Level 2 is taking place in Ballymoney. Photography courses are running in Cushendall. Manual Handling, Fork Lift / private truck and large machinery courses are also being delivered. There is the possibility of a 4 week course on nutrition and personal training.
