

TEAM FACTSHEET 2015/16

A 12-week personal development programme, helping young people to develop their confidence, motivation and skills through teamwork in the community.

Our aims

Through building their **confidence** and **motivation**Team members are encouraged to:

- → Think about their futures
- → Uncover hidden talents
- → Develop team-working and communication skills
- → Improve interview and CV writing techniques
- → Gain awareness of their **local community** and how they can contribute to it
- → Gain nationally recognised qualifications
- → Improve Language, Literacy and Numeracy skills (LLN)

The programme

The programme combines group and individual learning activities, both on site and outdoors. During the programme, Team members will:

Week 1: meet new people and plan ahead Week 2: enjoy lots of new experiences on residential Weeks 3-6: deliver a community volunteering project Weeks 7-8: complete a work placement of their choice

Week 9: plan for the future, with a focus on CVs and interviews

Weeks 10-11: take on a Team Challenge in their community

Week 12: celebrate with a Team presentation

Young people

Team attracts some of the hardest to reach young people. Participants are aged **16-25** and not in education, employment or training.

In 2015/16:

- → 9,252 young people took part in Team
- → After 6 months, 77% are back in education, employment, training or volunteering and 45% are in work
- → 31% of our young people have mental health problems
- → 10% were care-leavers
- → 18% experienced homelessness
- → 49% did not have 5 A*-C grades at GCSE
- → And 97% of our young people would recommend Team to other young people

Key facts

- → Since 1990, Team has supported over 196,000 young people
- → For every £1 invested in Team, £2.99 of social value is created
- → 65% of community projects would not have happened without the involvement of our Teams
- → Each Team invested the equivalent of £2,745 in their local community

Working in Partnership

Team is delivered by The Trust's network of delivery partners, ranging from **FE colleges** to the **Fire and Rescue Service.**

- → We work with over 120 delivery partners
- → Who run over **760** Teams per year

Delivery Partners are organisations that have the expertise to deliver the programme, providing high quality training and pastoral care to our young people. **The Prince's Trust** provides the tools, resources and support to delivery partners.
