

Background

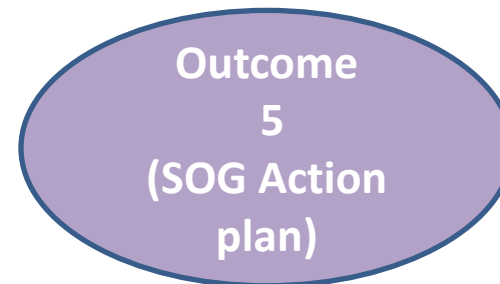
