

Background

Armagh Locality Planning Group (LPG) was established in 2010. Membership of the group includes a range of community, statutory and voluntary organisations with a remit for children and young people in the area. The group aims to improve the well-being of children and young people through a multiagency planning approach.

The group set their four priority areas for 2015-2017 which included the priority:

“To improve Funding opportunities for local groups. Improve knowledge and understanding for local voluntary and community groups completing funding applications!”

In May 2017 2 meetings were held with representatives from community associations in order to identify summer activities for children and young people in their area and to prepare funding proposals for these.

How much did we do?

- 6 community associations attended the sessions
- 4 services provided support and information around the funding process
- 2 sessions were held, each lasting 2 hours

How well did we do It?

- Low cost/no cost sessions
- Sessions held in local community centre in partnership with SHSCT, ABC Council and ABC Community Network
- 100% (all 6 respondents) rated the information given as good-excellent
- 100% responses rated the organisation of the sessions as good-excellent
- 100% reported they would be interested in meeting again for a similar event in the future

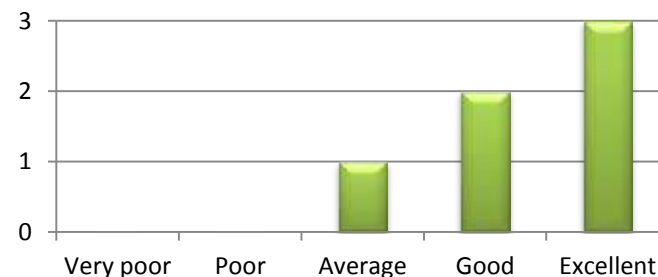
Is anyone better off?
