5.	Family Support Hub Update	The Hub is increasingly busy with continuation of capacity issues. The number of referrals is currently 23 this month with emotional and behavioural issues in young children one of the main issues.	
6.	Southern Area Outcomes Group	The Group has been working on its Action Plan for 2017-20. The Task and Finish Groups held their first event on Thursday 17th May 2018 in Armagh at the Epicentre. It was a Disability and Inclusion workshop around sharing good practice. 70 attendees and 6 speakers were involved on the day. Attendees received a Toolkit on how to make their service more accessible and Top Tips developed by Barnardos. The intention is to replicate this event within other areas of the Southern Trust.
