The Youth Fair for Carrickfergus was discussed. Valerie suggested Downshire as a venue following their refurbishment.

Roy is to get in touch with the Chair of the Learning Partnership to get a date and venue that suits the schools.

Andrew from Start 360 is currently organising the school fair in Antrim. He is happy to share his plans.

Evaluation – OBA: we need a baseline and it was suggested we should ask teachers to do something with the kids before and after the fair e.g., awareness of all organisations in the locality. Then the stall holders would be asked to report on any new people who have engaged following the event. This is to be explored more at the next meeting.

# <u>Andrew Millar – Start 360, Northern Connections</u>

Connectors and Responders Training -2 day training course on basic drugs and alcohol awareness and FRAMES model in how to positively respond to someone with drug/alcohol misuse issues. OCN Level 3 accreditation starts on  $7^{th}$  October but places are nearly full; however we can add your name for the next round of training if interested.

RAPID – looking to get small drug disposal bins installed in Carrick were people can anonymously dispose of any illegal/prescription drugs. Any suggestions of venues in Carrick would be welcome. Sainsbury's and Tesco have been difficult to engage with so far.

# <u>Grace Cahoon – Horizon Sure Start, Carrick and Larne</u>

Main update is that Larne and Carrick are now one project. We now have programmes up and running; currently based in All Saints Church, Linn Road, Larne and we are working on new premises in St. Anthony's Primary in Antiville. We are working to raise awareness of our project and the ward areas to cover. Carrick continues to be busy with programmes, 2 year programme, family support and raising health awareness.

# Valerie McKenzie - EA Youth Service

Update – major refurbishment in many of the Youth Centres; Greenisland, Sunnyland, Downshire and Whitehead Youth centre. While some are closed, by 2020 all centres will be open and offering 4 nights per week to young people. Lots of jobs in youth work will be available in the forthcoming weeks.

## Paula Martin – Action for Children; Family Support Hubs

Action for Children got tender for new hub contract on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. There are now 4 hub areas:

- Larne/Carrick/Newtownabbey
- 2. Antrim/Ballymena
- 3. Magherafelt/Cookstown
- 4. Coleraine/Ballymoney/Moyle.

New contract is for 2 years and 1 year.
