POLICE NON-EMERGENCY NUMBER

Call 101 when you want to contact your local police - when less urgent than a 999 call.

When should I call 101?

To report a crime or other concerns that do not require an emergency response. For example, if:

- Your car has been stolen
- Your property has been damaged
- You suspect drug use of dealing in your neighbourhood

Or to:

- Give the police information about a crime in your area
- Speak to the police about a general enquiry

You should always call 999 when it is an emergency, such as when a crime is in progress, someone suspected of a crime is nearby, when there is danger to life of violence is being used or threatened.

Your details:

The police will also need to know some details about you to confirm you are a genuine caller - your name, address, telephone number and date of birth. These details will **NOT** be made known to the offenders - unless you are a willing witness to the incident.

POLICE WILL NEVER CALL TO YOUR ADDRESS UNLESS YOU WANT THEM TO. SIMPLY TELL THE PERSON TAKING YOUR CALL AND THE POLICE WILL HONOUR THIS REQUEST.
