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	Outcomes Group Update
Achievements / Activities	A facilitated SEOG Workshop was held on the 9 th of February with good representation from a wide range of Outcomes Group members. At the workshop a range of ideas were explored in line with each of the four Regional Priorities. Following this, four working groups (aligned to each of the Priorities) were established with three of them having met to agree specific actions for the next 12 months. A number of these actions have already been completed, such as developing a new directory of services relating to supporting children impacted by the disruption to their school.
	The partnership SE Family Poverty Service completed in March, with over 400 of the most vulnerable families across the SE area being able to access a range of hardship related services. Please see the Impact Report for this service (enclosed). One of the working groups (aligned to the food and fuel poverty Regional Priority) has agreed to explore a 21/22 continuation of this service in partnership with all four Councils, the Department of Communities, the Trust and C&V sector partners.
Issues / Challenges	The continued impact of the pandemic means that local services are stretched in adapting to the lockdown and also dealing with increased demand from children and families, particularly in relation to mental health and poverty.
