Outcomes

Key Actions

- Establish new integrated Wellbeing Hubs to enhance step 1 and step 2 mental health services with HLCs, GP Federations, ICPs, Trusts, V&C sector and MDTs
- Contribute to the development of an App for family support services information led by ANDC
- Promote Take 5 Ambassador Training
- Develop the SET Outdoors initiative with partners

Children with Disabilities

Outcomes

- Recommendations from Our Journey are implemented in the South-Eastern Area
- Co-production with parents embedded in delivery and training

Key Actions

- Work to recommendations from "Our Journey Report"
- Establish a Knowledge College, co-produced with parents, to provide information and support to families

School Disruption

Outcomes

- Children and young people are supported during times of disruption to their schooling
- The delivery of Help Kids Talk is available across SE Area

Key Actions

- Produce a guide of services available to support children during school closures
- Help Kids Talk resources are available and promoted across the entire SE area
- Develop additional education support for children to help them achieve, especially at points of transition

Key Actions

• Develop a new integrated Hardship service for families with Councils, Trusts, CDNR, Barnardo's and others working in close partnership to ensure vulnerable families can be supported with help relating to utilities, heat, and food during 21/22 across the SE area.
