

BACKGROUND & CONTEXT

Locality Planning Groups (LPG's) are partnerships between statutory, voluntary and community organisations working with and for children, young people and families at a local level. Their work focuses on early intervention to improve outcomes for children and young people. One of the key aims of an LPG is to identify any unmet or emerging needs regarding children, young people and families and take collective action to address these on a local basis.

The emotional wellbeing and mental health of children and young people has long been a top priority for LPG's across Northern Ireland. Many of the challenges have been amplified by Covid 19 and associated restrictions and these have been raised at LPG meetings by practitioners.

From July to September 2020, the Northern Area LPG's surveyed 474 parents and 127 children & young people to collect views on health and wellbeing needs, and the top need was Emotional Health and Wellbeing, with Mental Health as a key priority. At the same time, Southern Area LPG's were collecting evidence for their 2021-24 Action Plans and again Emotional Wellbeing and Mental Health were top of the priority needs.

An agreement was made between members of the Mid Ulster LPG to host an event in March 2020 to highlight key support services for children and young people. Due to Covid19 this event was put on hold until now. It was identified that, in order to gain a more collective and representative understanding of the range of local services, the Dungannon LPG should be invited to work in partnership on this to provide a fuller understanding of the range of services across the Mid Ulster District Council Area.

Both the Mid Ulster and Dungannon Locality Planning Groups are delighted to host this event and have produced this resource for all attendees to provide a reference as to the large number of support services across the Mid Ulster District Council Area.

All of the organisations included have information stands on the day, so please take some time to find out more at our 'Can We Talk' event.

This is usually a sibling or parent but can be a grandparent/aunt/uncle etc. Our aim with the young people is to reduce the negative impact of the caring role on the young person, we use the Outcome Star model to identify which areas are impacted (Health, Education, How you feel, Managing at Home, Finances, Caring Role) and then create an action plan with the Young Person to help them achieve their own goals, primarily through 1:1 support and working with the family/professional network around the child.
