




#### How Well Did We Do It





# Is Anyone Better Off? What are your main take-home messages from today's conference?

We are stronger together

The importance of better connecting and expanding universal services including through the C&V sector providers

The conference pointed up the importance of locality groups in ensuring good comms and organisations working together

Together we are doing a great job for our children and families.

Everything is rooted in relationships -the parent infant relationship is fundamental. Liked the dispel myth message-you cannot spoil a baby -this needs to be shared widely in population.

Keep joining up the services and language across them

The importance of working together to avoid duplication.

The huge breadth of work taking place is phenomenal!
