





Antenatal Stage

- Support and information provided to parents-to-be to reduce anxiety experienced perinatally due to the prospect of giving birth and parenting an infant whilst isolated during a pandemic.
- Increased awareness of strong parent and child relationships and the beginnings of this when baby is in the womb.
- Increased parental knowledge of connection to bump and building relationship with unborn baby through all stages of pregnancy through singing, talking & reading to bump, touch, building connection between bump and baby being in the world with his/her parents.







Early Days and Under One

Babbling Babies 4 week Programme

- 100% of those who responded reported they had learnt lots of activities they could do with their child
- 100% reported that prior to the Programme they knew little or nothing about baby brain development, attachment and the importance of talking, singing and playing with their baby – afterwards all reported they knew lots!
- 100% of those who responded enjoy using the songs and rhymes in their own home
