ARE YOU PASSIONATE ABOUT?...

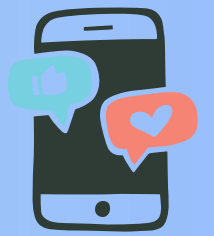
- having a platform to have your voice heard

We can support you to gain valuable skills and experience to take with you into other areas of your life such as parenting, employment and volunteering, among others.

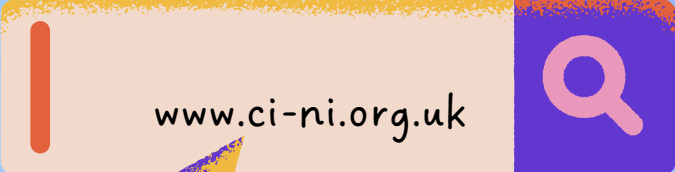
