CONTEXT & BACKGROUND

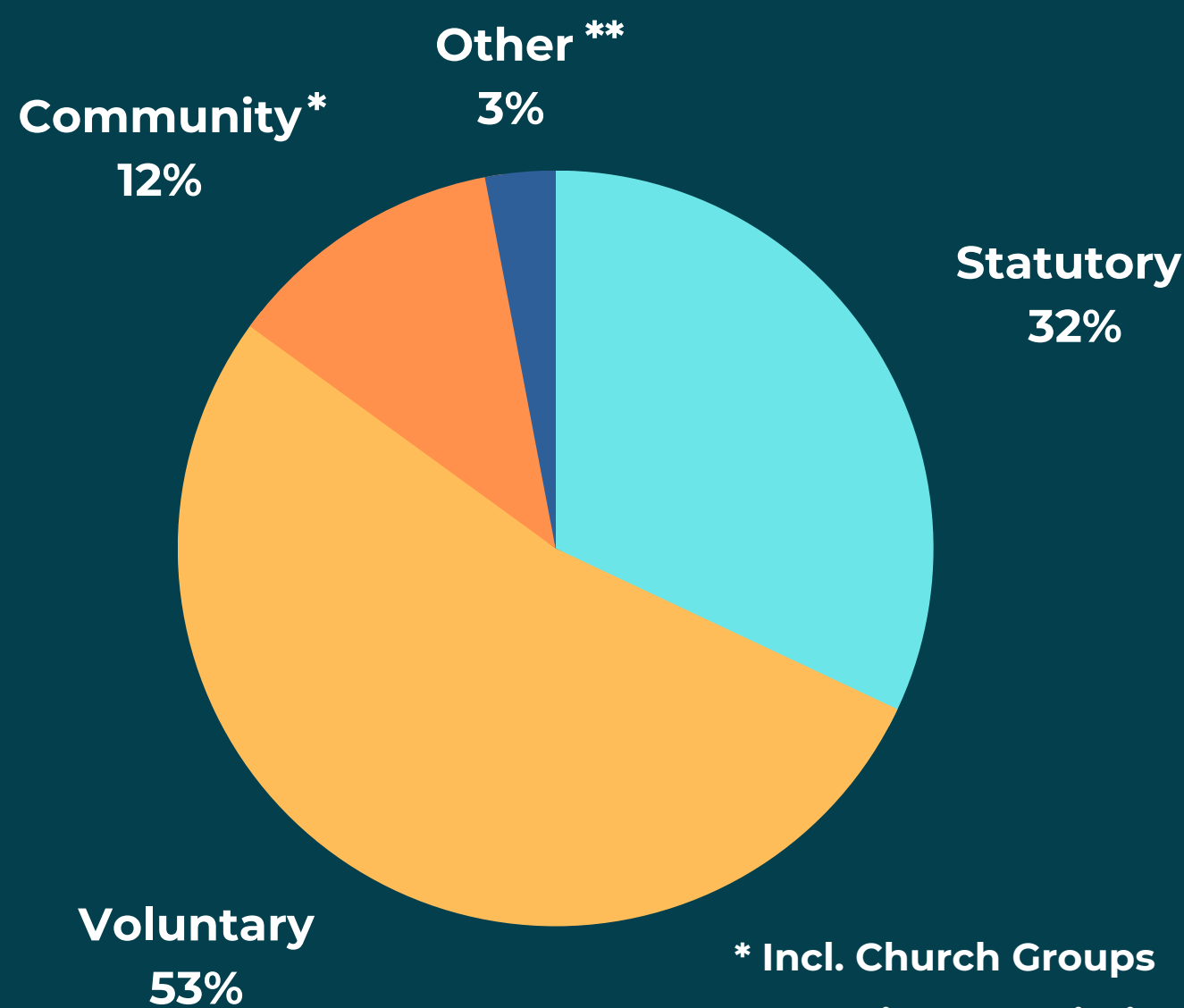
The Feel Good Armagh Community Networking Event was held on Friday 9th June 2023, at the City of Armagh Hotel, from 10am to 1pm. The event was funded by Ark and Triangle Housing and Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council.

Members of Armagh Locality Planning Group had identified the need to showcase support services for families in the Armagh area, aimed at all ages. Local service providers attended to inform the public and each other of support available for the local population.

A Planning Group was set up to organise the event which was made up of a range of services. (See below.)

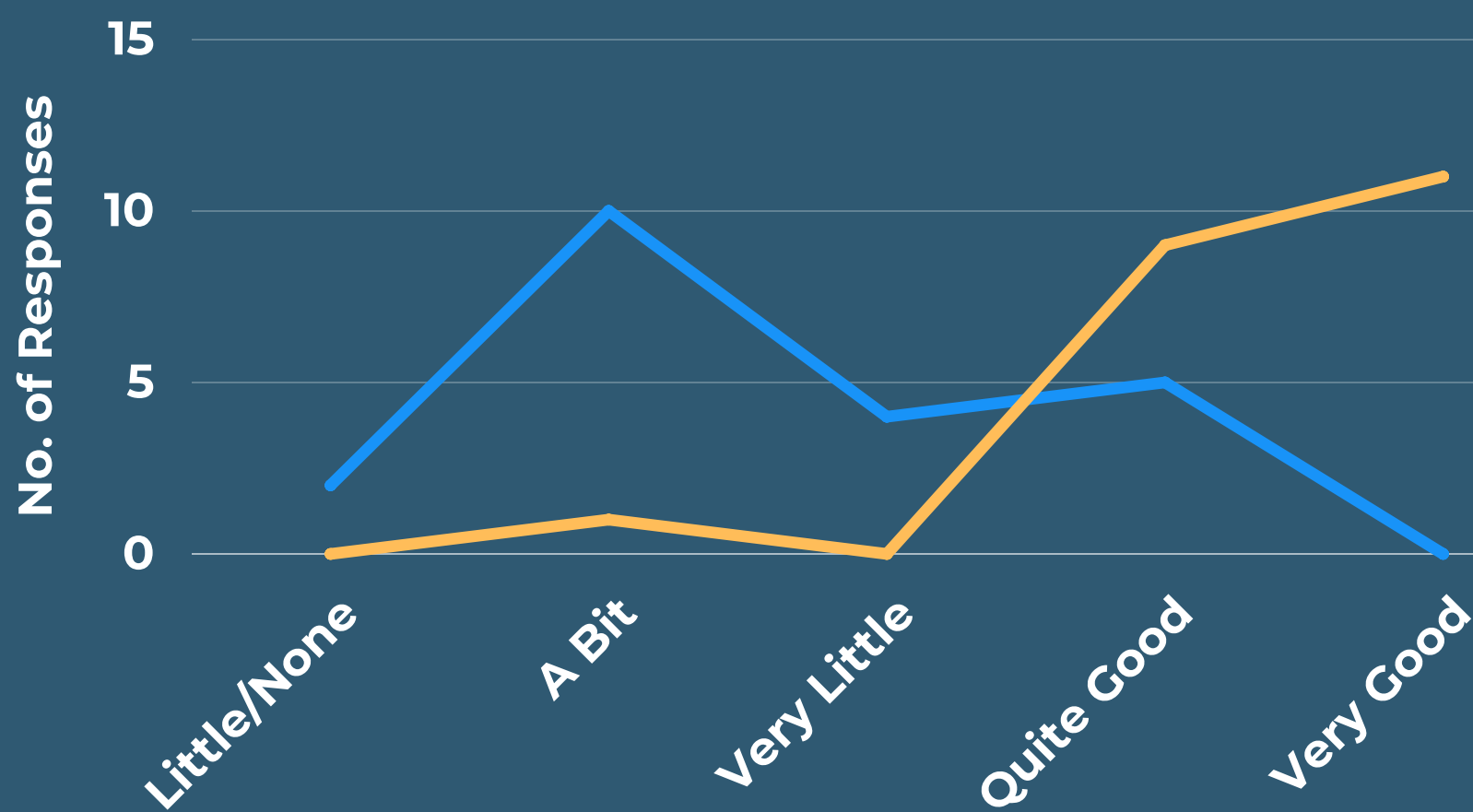

Stall holders were asked to give a rough estimate of how much information was exchanged with people who visited their stall. This included members of the public as well as other stall holders and we counted a piece of information as leaflet distributed, contact shared or query answered relating to their service.

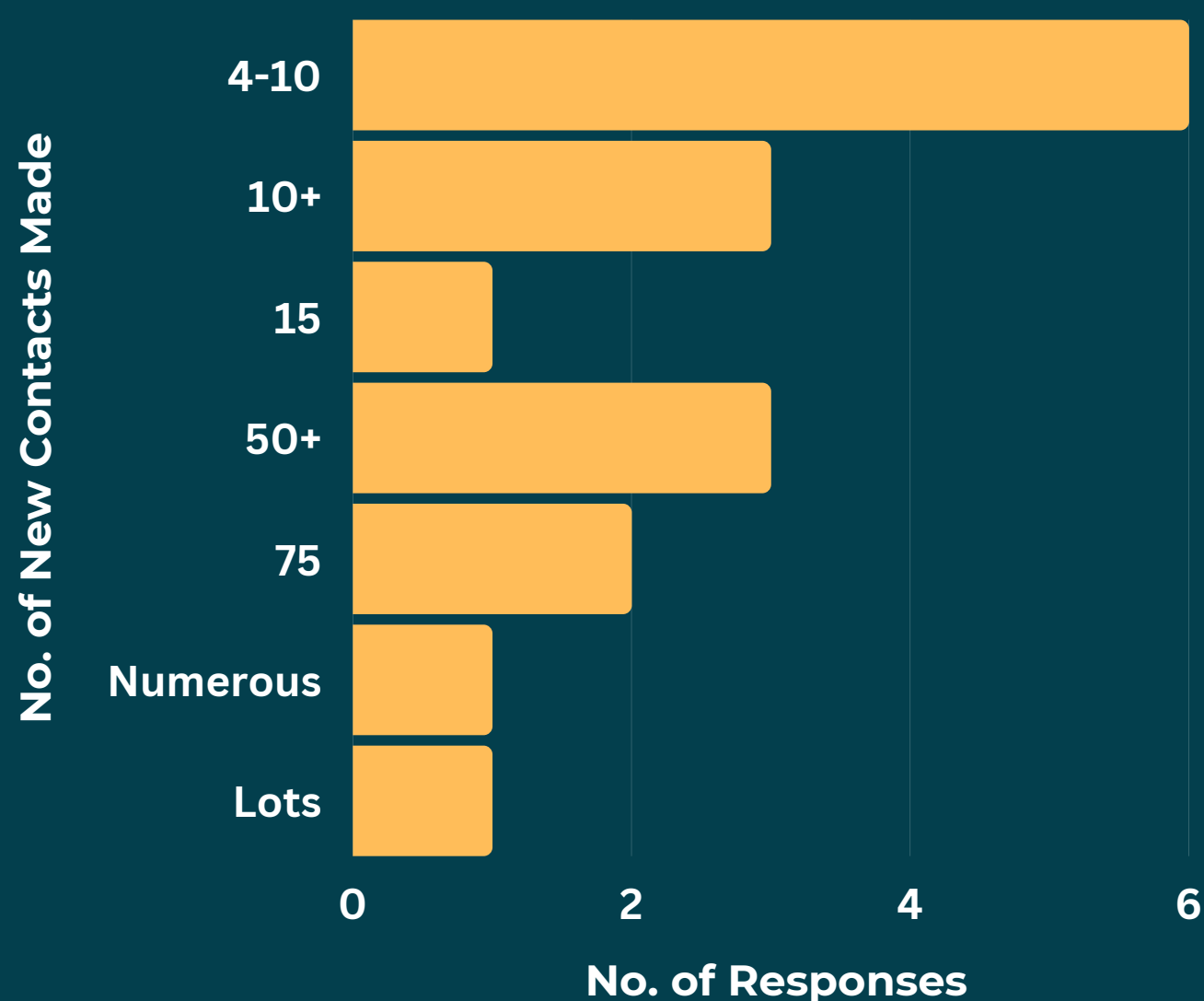
ESTIMATED PIECES OF INFORMATION EXCHANGED FROM 32% OF STALLS



This total estimates at least 500 pieces of information exchanged from 21 stalls - 32% of total stalls on the day.

This suggests that over 1000 pieces of information were exchanged at all 66 stalls if we take this sample as the average number.
