<b>FSH Update</b>	Lisa ( <b>NIACRO/FSH</b> ): Referral nos. settled around target but bracing for usual June influx. Dip in referrals from community paediatrics, possibly due to Single Point of Entry Team pilot. Usual referrals on emotional & behavioural issues within ages 5-10. Recently had referrals for 2 families with teenage children and impact of their father's sexual offences. The Hub continues to seek info. on summer activities. The FSH is moving back towards face-to-face meetings, which will lead to better discussions.

Pack</b> launched on 22<sup>nd</sup> May at Stormont. This practical resource has been prepared in co-production with parents/carers. Link to follow.</p> <p><b>SHSCT-Funded ESOL Pilots</b> are taking place in the City of Armagh High School and St. Patrick’s in Dungannon. Darren will feed back on related learnings in due course.</p> <p>CYPSP, PSNI, EA Youth Service and SHSCT Sexual Health Team recently met to discuss issues on <b>Sextortion</b>. Currently gathering info. on available resources, in advance of producing a short video message for dissemination on social media.</p>

Members encouraged to share relevant PSNI messaging with young people &amp; families with whom they work.</p> <p>Deborah (<b>Home-Start Craigavon</b>): Facing an online versus face-to-face programme delivery dilemma, as certain formats suit certain parents/families better, so continuing with a mix of both.
