Update from Family Support Hub	Ann-Marie (Barnardo's NI / FSH): Hub remains busy, referrals increasing monthly. Still receiving requests for financial help and are referring onto organisations such as BCM. Recently received some referrals from schools - positive they are linking into the Hub. School refusal continues as an issue and the Hub are fortunate to have REACT in the area to refer young people into. Noticing gaps in services, particularly disability support.
