| Action Planning 2024-27 | <p>Feel Good Armagh - Community Networking Event Subgroup Meeting recently took place to review this year's event - General consensus was that footfall & engagement with the public was improved upon in 2024. Two issues highlighted were timing and how the event was publicised, so a Survey Monkey was circulated by CYPSP to garner feedback/suggestions. 2025 Planning ongoing and to further discuss in new year.</p> <p>Group discussion on challenges facing statutory, voluntary and community organisations on staff recruitment / retention / wellbeing and funding challenges took place. Michael, Mark, Caelan & Joe met and there are specific elements which they have no power over changing, e.g. salary scales. Rolling out more youth work training across the ABC Council Area was discussed as a possible option, funding dependent.</p> <p>The BSO Interpreting Service have been considering how to overcome the language barriers and access to interpreting services across NI and are looking at piloting an initiative in the SHSCT Area to recruit more interpreters through schools, colleges and other local organisations. | FSH Update | Ann-Marie (Barnardo's NI / FSH): Referrals to FSH increasing again and continuing to be more complex. Number of repeat referrals have been submitted. Encouraging families to work with the services provided to them and have reminded families that services are limited and in demand. Families often do not disclose if involved with other services such as Women's Aid, for a variety of reasons. Fortunate that the Hub members can share additional information at meetings. | |
