Recently introduced a new Intermediate Group (for 11-13 year olds), to accommodate some Year 8 young people who were reluctant to attend the Senior Group.	

	Chris (New-Bridge Integrated College): EBSA is a major issue. Possible shift in focus for their part-time Welfare & Care Officer to home visits, with the aim of encouraging soft returns. Anger & behavioural and drugs & alcohol (New App 'Signal' being used to sell products) issues are on the increase. Stress & anxiety are ongoing issues.
