Self-Care Session	<p><i>Supported by the PHA through the Clear Project.</i></p> <p>Conversations focused on the 'Connect' element of Take 5 in 2 Breakout Rooms. Members shared topics discussed including maintaining physical connections in work with hybrid working, increase in machines in shops leading to less face-to-face conversations, young people recognising the need to disconnect from their phones, physical activities, sports clubs, yoga and Tai-Chi helping people to connect, the need to disconnect and take time for yourself & setting personal boundaries, face-to-face LPG meetings being more conducive to networking and in-person programmes helping young people develop their social skills. Action Planning 2024-27	BSO Interpreting Service have been considering how to overcome the language barriers and access to interpreting services across NI and are looking at piloting an initiative in the SHSCT Area, to recruit more interpreters through schools, colleges and other local organisations. Online Briefing Session forthcoming.	DC to provide further info., when available
FSH Update	Lisa (NIACRO / FSH): Exceptionally low month of referrals in September, but spike in no. of children placed on Child Protection Register via Gateway. Referrals increasing again with familiar issues: returning to school, school anxiety and avoidance. Significant no. of young people with issues around diet and eating: some involved with CAMHS Eating Disorder Team and not engaging; others are overeating and comfort eating. Laura Wheatley has moved from CIP to AMH and is scoping EWB needs for the 9-25 age group, with a view to delivery of a programme to build on previous Peace IV work on transgenerational trauma. The Hub has been asked to carry out scoping on the Family Support element of the Ray Jones Review on capacity challenges and local service gaps.

One Stop Shop now available as a drop-in based in Newry City Library, on first Thursday of every month. Dan (Cedar Foundation): Continuing to provide a variety of programs and social activities for young people under age 18 with diagnosis of autism, physical disability or learning difficulties.
