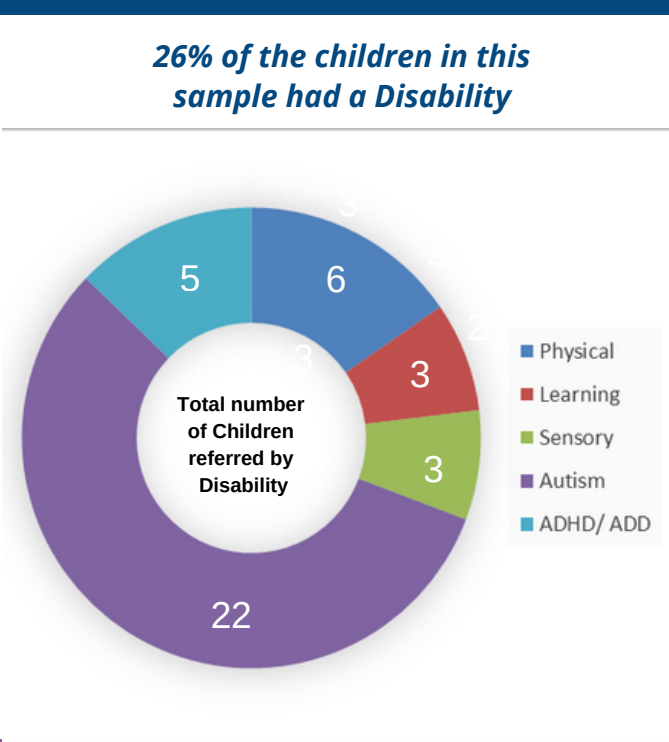
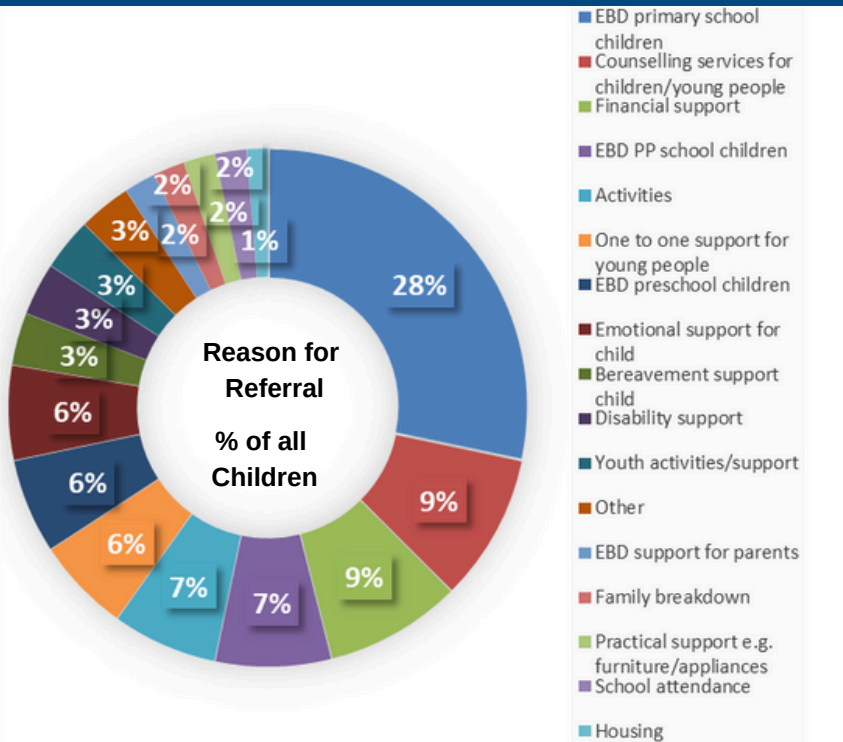


102 family sample questionnaires completed

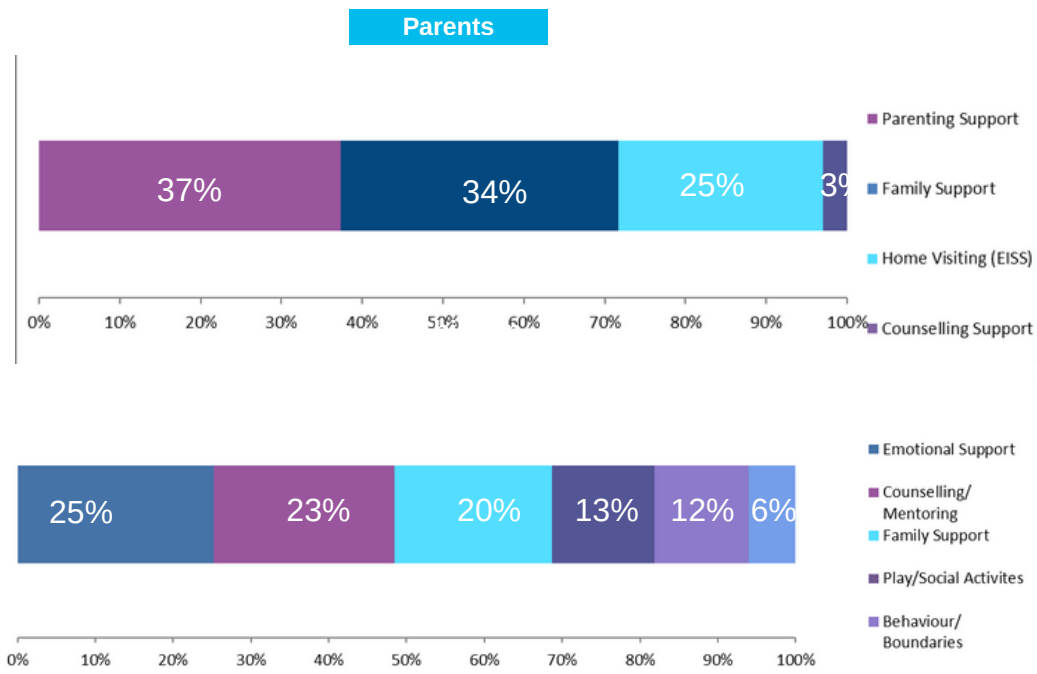
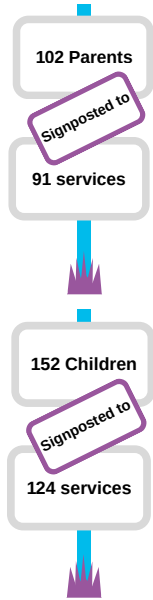


Outcomes of Service Intervention

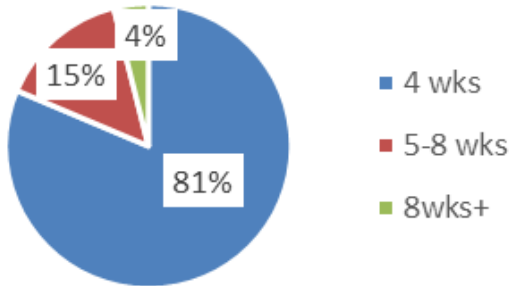
- 89** parents/child did not need referral to statutory Social Services
- 94** parents/child found intervention had a positive outcome
- 100** parents found the process of engaging with a Hub worked well
- 97** parents received written/verbal information and an explanation about the FSH

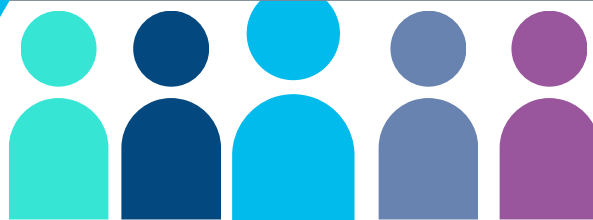
Did engagement with Hub work well?

Mum said she was grateful for the help, she doesn't know what they would of done without it, it has set her child up for the summer too as she has so many activities she can attend and is excited to attend. She would recommend the hubs.

Dad shared that staff were friendly, approachable and engaging with the Hub was comfortable and an easy process.

Mum felt the programme encouraged the young person to open up more about their feelings and increased their self-esteem and confidence.

Yes, I felt I was able to understand my child's behaviour more and learnt techniques to manage his behaviours better.



Did intervention have positive outcomes?

Mum reports a big difference in her daughter's presentation and mood since attending the therapy sessions **'the difference is unbelievable'**.

The workshop was **fabulous** - my daughter could't wait to attend each week

It has had a **positive outcome**, the child has gained friendships, improved her social engagement and also alleviated some of the negative behaviours that led to the hub referral.

Dad shared that the process was **excellent**, especially with the convenience of accessing all services through a single referral.

Mum has found the work from AFC Choices to be working **extremely well**. She described the worker as amazing, fantastic, patient and comes consistently to her home every week.

Mum found it **very helpful** and opened her eyes to what ASD can mean for a child/family.

Mum stated she can already see **an improvement** in her child within 4 visits from Choices.
