1. Welcome and Introductions

Save the Children OBA report card – Kate to resend.

Update - Save the Children are supporting Ukrainian families, 10 households with 26 children being supported. Kate will inform the group of any up-to-date regional information.

School Uniform Initiatives – Bronagh liaised with Jenny Archer, Causeway Coast and Glens Borough Council to compile a list of school uniform initiatives in the area.



Cost of Living Crisis Conference held in the Vineyard – Anita attended and felt it was a great networking opportunity.

Una Forsythe found that in Ballymoney High School free meals are on the decline since move to online, parents may be unaware they have to apply yearly. An event was held to show parents how to apply – one person attended. It was felt that it was an opportunity to look at other schools to see if there is a trend.

Alcohol Misuse – Michele stated that there is an increase in alcohol consumption with young people, alcohol is cheaper and easily accessible. Start360 to speak to young people.

4. Guest Speakers – Kori McLaughlin, CYPSP Youth Wellness Hub
Kori spoke of the CYPSP Youth Wellness Web, designed by young people for
young people – central information point. There are three sections within the
webpage: Age 8-10, 11-15 and 16+. Issues covered include bereavement,
bullying etc. Easy to navigate, includes contact helplines. There is also a
Parent/Teacher zone including resources/training materials for parents and
teachers. The training zone is split into each Health and Social Care Trust
area showing free mental health training that is available.

Kori or Valerie Maxwell will share information on the webpage, ensuring no endorsements and the information is up-to-date and relevant.

5. Causeway Locality Budget

Bronagh mentioned the budget last year for funding applications was £2,000. Five projects were given £400. Possible amount could be less this year, as room hire for meetings needs to be taken out of the budget. Expressions of Interests to be sent out October time and that funding will be spent before end of financial year.

6. Family Support Hub Update

Bronagh gave the update in Nicola's absence. At the moment the Family Support Hub are reviewing partnership agreements. If anyone has still to complete, please forward to FSH email.

Bronagh mentioned that there is an issue with using interpreters. It was suggested using the Big Word but Kate said this was for use within the Trust.

7. CYPSP Causeway LPG Action Plan

Bronagh will update the action plan and send round draft paper to the subgroup to agree and finalise. The main priorities will remain the same as the previous year - mental health/emotional wellbeing, education, sports and fitness, and health. Under education, staff training is available with regards to trauma and under the health section, poverty to be included.
