### 4. Guest Speaker – John McCleod Solihull

Question on how new staff can be trained in Solihull and existing staff updated. Options include – whole staff approach, refresher courses and multi user licence. NHSCT have some spaces on the 2 day foundation course face to face which close next Weds 15<sup>th</sup> of March.



The multi user license enables people to log on an access an extensive variety of courses for free. When people register they then have unlimited access. Courses include 'Impact of the Pandemic on Teenagers' and 'Understanding your Child's Brain.' The Safeguarding board are providing this access until next year. Follow the QR code and use the code Families NI to register. It is possible to register from a mobile too. Further courses are also being developed for professionals such as doctors, psychologists and nurses such as 'Understanding your Wellbeing in high pressured environments' The courses have to be paid for in the rest of the UK.

# 5. Causeway Locality Budget

Bronagh mentioned the projects funded in 22/23 and asked the group their opinions on how the 23/24 funding should be spent. There was a general consensus that the small grants programmes were a useful way of spending the money. It was commented that the extra financial support for groups was much needed at this time and also that it was a visible way for the CYPSP LPG to have impact on the local community. It was also highlighted that it would be beneficial for members to partner on projects in future.

### 6. Counselling Services for Children

Members voted in favour of allocating the remainder of the 22/23 budget to counselling sessions for children. Sessions funded will be delivered by Links Counselling services. 10 sessions for £500 will be funded by the LPG this will be matched by the NHSCT who will fund a further 10 sessions in the Causeway area.
