Requests for additional and more complicated support including alcohol safety in families. Requests for finance also increased and continue to be declined. Ballysaggart is a target area. Strategic Action Plan to be produced and shared with stakeholders: a live document to allow emerging needs to be addressed. Working towards post programme/intervention sustainability and will also be trying to influence policy and systems. A community-informed, department-led approach will be adopted.
