

Autism Cafés 2025



March 2025 saw the end of the Western Health and Social Care Trust Autism Support Cafes for the financial year. Coordinated by the Health Improvement, Equality and Involvement Department in partnership with local councils and Community organisations, the cafes bring together statutory and community and voluntary sector services. These services offer support to adults, parents, carers and their families who have an Autism diagnosis, are awaiting assessment or indeed are displaying early indicators that they may be Neurodiverse.

Our last café took place in Castlepark Leisure Centre, Lisnaskea to coincide with the beginning of Autism Acceptance week 2025. With over 20 services regularly attending the different cafés over the last year to provide information, support and signposting, the cafés have proven to be popular with service users.
