

Two events for families living in the Belleek / Garrison area organised by Fermanagh LPG Members and FODC



As a result of local consultation while crafting FODC Community Plans local people in the Belleek / Garrison area identified how people of all ages who are Carers experience isolation and loneliness and the challenge of addiction. To support the local community two collaborative events were organised to bring awareness of support directly into the heart of the community. Both events were opportunities for LPG members to visit the new Belleek Community Hub and meet local residents.

Parent Participation Project (Parent Line / CINI) kindly assisted with consulting with families with children / young people living in the area about their experience of isolation and loneliness through a face-to-face survey tool. Learning from this will guide future events / planning in regard of the needs and wants of this local community.



Additionally, YGAM facilitated an evening session for families in the area and interested LPG members focusing particular on children & young people's attachment to online gaming. As well as awareness sessions such as these for families, YGAM can offer groups/ organisations further City & Guild leadership training into Gambling and Gaming addiction, which will be an addition to their practice and Safeguarding Policies.
