FSH Update	Lisa (NIACRO / FSH): Busy summer. Referrals from GPs, Health Visitors, CAMHS, Gateway and self-referrals. Requests included challenging behaviour at home, return to school (including anxiety, transitions & Autism/ADHD/ASD assessment pathways), long waiting lists for ADHD/ASD assessments. Increase in ages 16-18 not consenting to receive support despite parents' wishes. Programmes available for employability but difficult to get young people out the connecting. FSH would be keen to know about local mentoring options.	

Member Agency Updates	<p>Naj / Lisa (PIPS Hope and Support): Thanks to all who supported recent Baton Of Hope Event. Increase in people reaching out as a result, particularly in Lurgan. Congratulations offered to PIPS by the LPG. Postvention service for children continues. 18-20 year olds engaging more with service and sharing 'FYI' with all counsellors for signposting. Thrive Project is in Portadown, Craigavon & Lurgan and happy to work in partnership to deliver.</p> <p>Majd (The King's Trust): Wide range of programmes running for ages 16-30 across NI and can deliver bespoke programmes in given areas if there is a corresponding need identified (Max. 16, Min. 6 participants). Offer both employability and wellbeing programmes.</p> <p>Johnny (DfE, Careers Service): Working with local schools to identify priority pupils in Yr 12 to offer face-to-face/1-1 sessions focusing on career support. Delivering wider group work and career talks in post-primary schools.</p> <p>Deirdre (EA Youth Service): REACH Programme available to all local primary & post-primary schools. REACH Champion Programme in schools. Work on whole school basis or with smaller groups. Teacher Awareness Workshops available with booklet to support and Parent Workshops can be delivered with accompanying toolkit. Worked with a group of Y9&10 Boys in New-Bridge and Chris would highly recommend the programme.</p> <p>Veronica (SHSCT, MDT): Connected Parents Autism / ADHD Support Group meets 1st & 3rd Wednesday monthly in Rathfriland Community Centre, 9.30am-11.30am.</p> <p>Chandara / Rebecca (IncredAble): Heroes Plus Project is delivered in Banbridge Area, supporting young people with a learning disability and/or additional needs.
