Background

The Armagh LPG is a partnership of statutory, voluntary, and community organisations working to improve outcomes for children and young people in the Armagh area.

Meeting five times a year, the group shares information, builds connections, identifies local needs, and works together to address them. It is supported by the Children and Young People's Strategic Partnership (CYPSP).

Since 2023, member organisations have hosted an annual community networking event to connect people of all ages with local services and supports.

Feel Good Armagh Community Networking Event made a contribution to all 8 High Level Outcomes for Children in the 2020-30 NI Children and Young People's Strategy where the well-being of children and young people includes:

- Physical and mental health
- Enjoyment of play and leisure
- Learning and achievement

How well did we do it?



How effective was today's event for your service/organisation in connecting with communities in Armagh?

Great to get the **chance to speak** on a deeper level than just advertising ourselves!

Many people were not **aware** of the service and referenced that they would like to use it in the **future**.

It's a massive chance for us to **get ourselves known** to community and other services.

Very useful to give my **contact** details to organisations working with young people who need **support** with training / education / employment.

What has changed as a result?



Roughly how many people did you speak with at your stall (Try to give a number of people you spoke with to give them information about your service / organisation)?

Information Stand Holders were asked to give a rough estimate of the amount of people they spoke with at their stand to gain an understanding of the interaction on the day. (This included members of the community and other stand holders.)

1,079

Overall, the 37 respondents estimated talking to **1,079** people on the day, giving an average of **29** people per information stand

1,254

For the **43** information stands, using the average number of feedback from the **37** respondents, it is estimated that stall holders spoke with around **1,254** people on the day



Feedback from stall holders reported the event provided a **valuable networking opportunity**, bringing together a **wide range of services** in the one place, enabling **community connection, information sharing**, and **increased awareness of local and regional support**, despite some concerns about **promotion and attendance**.

What has changed as a result?



On average, how many pieces of information would you have given to visitors to your stall (Rough estimate the number of things you would have told)?

Information Stand holders were asked to give a rough estimate of the amount of pieces of information they gave to visitors to their stall. (This included distribution of information leaflets, contact details and other relevant information to their service.)

2,115

Overall, the 37 respondents estimated sharing of **2,115** pieces of information on the day, giving an average of **57** pieces of information shared at each table

2,458

For the **43** information stands, using the average number of feedback from the **37** respondents, it is estimated that stall holders gave out around **2,458** pieces of information to visitors on the day



Feedback from stall holders highlighted the event's value in **raising awareness, sharing information, and building meaningful connections with both the public and other organisations**, with many noting it was a **rare opportunity to engage directly** and **promote their services** to previously unaware audiences.

What has changed as a result?

The event was **highly valued** for being **well-organised**, offering **strong networking opportunities**, **raising service awareness**, and **fostering community engagement**, with highlights including the use of gazebos, hospitality touches like coffee tokens, and positive connections made.



Some suggestions for improvement were made, including **better advertising**, a **more central location** like Market Street, **less grassy/muddy terrain**, **indoor or covered children's activities**, and **consideration of weather impacts**.
