<b>FSH Update</b> <i>Update provided via e-mail</i>	Ann-Marie ( <b>Barnardo's NI / FSH</b> ): FSH currently undergoing some changes: Pat McGeough has retired. Gillian McKeown from Barnardo's is the new Hub Co-ordinator. Ann-Marie now based in Grange Building, Tower Hill (E-mail remains same, new telephone no. to follow.) Hub now has an agreement in place with Bolster who work with families open to Children with Disability Social Workers: can take 5 referrals a month from Jan to end of March, hoped that PACT will then continue to take referrals after that. Emerging trend: Repeat referrals from different agencies, therefore it is important for referral agencies to ask families if they have been directed to the FSH previously.	
<b>Member Agency Updates</b>	<p>Caroline (<b>Youth Justice Agency</b>): Busy with early intervention work and delivery of workshops in local schools. Recently linked with SRC to deliver workshops and happy to connect LPG members with SRC. Have some funding to work with young people at risk of offending behaviours; Contact Caroline to further discuss.</p> <p>Ainé (<b>PSNI</b>): Sextortion a daily issue throughout the district, more prevalent amongst young people. Safeguarding a key priority for the PSNI, as well as getting relevant messaging into the community. Neighbourhood Team working with Women's Aid on domestic violence and healthy relationships: have been in Armagh High School and due to go into St. Catherine's.</p> <p>Jamie (<b>Volunteer Now</b>): Live Volunteer Now Training Schedule <a href="#">HERE</a> and info on Volunteer Now Impact Awards <a href="#">HERE</a> Annual event on 25<sup>th</sup> March. <p><b>Member Agency Updates</b></p>	<p>Catherine (<b>SHSCT</b>): Recently had the Autism Bus from England funded through Neighbourhood Renewal, feedback very positive. New network of local Verve Health Trainers who can be booked for health events or programmes and 1-to-1 support.</p> <p>Dan (<b>Cedar Foundation</b>): Continuing to link with local organisations such as Start360 on programmes. Referral processing &amp; activities continue. Dan is moving roles.</p> <p>Padraig (<b>REACT</b>): Huge demand continues for mentor programme with referrals ongoing from FSH. Full schedule of programmes in the centre. PCSP supporting a young girls group focusing on EVAWG. Dungeons &amp; Dragons group is proving popular. Joint creative writing project has started with a group in Monaghan.</p> <p>Niamh (<b>Advocacy VSV</b>): Only charity in NI to offer a professional service to victims of sexual violence in the safety of their own home. Service is for 16+ yrs. New worker (Sinead Travers) now in place and LPG members are invited to attend the opening of their new Dungannon Office, in The Junction, on 19<sup>th</sup> March at 1pm.</p> <p>Ellie (<b>NICMA</b>): Running Child Minding Academies in 10 council areas in NI but ABC Area not one of them. NICMA Childcare Survey <a href="#">HERE</a> on Understanding Childcare Needs of Families with Children with Disabilities/Additional Needs: deadline tomorrow.</p> <p>Cillian (<b>Start360</b>): Increase in demand for vaping sessions, particularly from schools. Use of snuff and illicit substances in vapes seems to be on the rise.</p> <p>Adrian (<b>EA Youth Service</b>): Epicentre currently running range of programmes &amp; drop-ins for varying age groups and different times. Go Lead youth project coming to an end. An IWD Event has been organised by some young people in the centre.
