Agenda Item	Discussion	Action - By Whom
Welcome, Apols., Mins 24/09	Darren welcomed all to the meeting. Brief introductions made. Previous Minutes agreed. Darren confirmed Clanrye Group do not have a premises in Banbridge. Kevin (EA Youth Service) has been off so the conversation offering support to a group of 18-24 year olds with ASD, mental/emotional trauma & self-harm needs based in the Rathfriland Area is to be picked up imminently. FSH Update	Lisa (NIACRO / FSH): Increase in referrals to FSH which is to be expected with return to school. Continue to receive complex cases including need for bereavement support and those waiting for ASD/ADHD Assessments. Increase in young people aged 14+ unable to avail of NIACRO CAPS and at a higher level of need, however not high enough for Gateway thresholds: some not engaging with services and others with statutory involvement and not showing progress. Update on plans following Review for Family Support (Work Stream 9), with the Southern Trust Hubs viewed as a successful model of partnership between statutory, voluntary and community services. Envisaged that FSH's will be an integral part in this change to be supported by transformation funding.	

Member Agency Updates	<p>MarySue (SHSCT MDT): Taking the lead with Banbridge GPs. Delivering Anxiety Yoga in locals schools. Physiotherapists and the Primary Mental Health will be in situ in the MDTs in the Craigavon & Portadown Areas, before Social Workers.</p> <p>Gina (EA Youth Service): Record Junior attendance recorded at Youth Centre, which is positive but capacity pressures. Recent events included Girls Night In, upcoming Christmas activities scheduled. Ongoing challenges include behavioural issues, damage, and managing boundaries with high-needs young people.</p> <p>David (SHSCT): Running a 6-week Men's Project with Lawrencetown Community Association and Boys & Girls Club, focus on health & wellbeing. Collaborating with Gold Line Youth Centre who have offered places on weekly Young Women's Project, running to Christmas. 6-week Pottery Project launched with a local artist at Portadown Wellness Centre and have annual Snow Tubing and Santa Day with ABC Council in December. Very busy period, high demand for places. Challenges to find organisations to support young people with complex needs including providing personal care, but continue working to meet those needs. Team has recently grown and hope to fill another Support Worker post soon.</p> <p>Ainé (PSNI): Recently hosted a 2-day work experience event for schools across ABC Council Area: 50 students attending, 30 of whom from Banbridge & Dromore Area. The event provided insight into careers in policing, and feedback from participants was very positive.</p>
