Speaker	Roberta Johnson (Playboard NI): Presented to the group on Playboard NI's Our Generation Spaces To Be Programme, focusing on 9-11 yrs in school/community settings offering training and facilitated play sessions. Our Generation Learning Lab is also available offering a range of free training workshops for those working with 9-25 yrs.	Spaces To Be Flyer & Referral Form to be circulated by JP
FSH Update	Lisa (NIACRO / FSH): Post summer referrals increased: good range from services/agencies and self-referrals, a lot for complex needs. Met with SHSCT to discuss forward-planning. Bolster Community to provide family support alongside the Hub. Current issues: Families awaiting ASD/ADHD Assessment, 5-10 year old age group, pre-school	

FSH Update	age and teens needing mentoring support. Linking into long-terms supports with EA Youth Service. Continuing to connect families into Oasis programmes.	
Member Agency Updates	<p>Chantelle/Abigail (Barnardo's NI): Several programmes across all of NI: Young People's Regional Group, free Disability Awareness Training, Transition Programmes in Schools and Sixth Sense Youth Groups. Referral form to be shared with CYPS.</p> <p>Naj (PIPS Hope & Support): Christmas Service on 14th Dec, St. Mary's Church, Newry. 'I Picked A Date' TikTok is currently trending, suggesting for users to pick a date to self-harm or end their lives.</p> <p>Adrian (EA Youth Service): Delivering frontline services across local centres (Craigavon, Drumgor and Tullygally), open 4 evenings a week. Continually assessing needs, in consultation with young people. Visit HERE for further info. on funding currently available from the Education Authority. Some newcomer families are reluctant to disclose information to statutory organisations when completing programme application forms.</p> <p>Deborah (Home Start Craigavon): Continuing to offer Befriender Service (delivered by volunteers), along with Group Work. Dads Programme now available which includes Baby Massage: group has to be a min. size of 6 participants.</p> <p>Sharon (Bolster Community): Autism Connect Services are currently being provided in the area – specifically aimed at autistic adults.</p> <p>Alex (ABC Council): More children & young people with additional needs coming into programmes and sometimes parents do not raise related needs in advance.</p> <p>Helen (DfE RAISE Programme): Dept of Education RAISE Programme webpage HERE for further info. on RAISE. First call for locality led projects has closed and all proposals have been assessed. Subject to outcome of an ongoing Judicial Review, applicants to be contacted in coming weeks. Intending to open a further call in 2026 inviting project proposals to deliver against remaining locality objectives. Online Stakeholder Information Sessions are forthcoming. Member Agency Updates	<p>Tim (Youth Justice Agency): Working with 10-18 yrs involved in offending behaviour or at risk of offending. Team has recently expanded to reflect nos. in the area. Aiming to increase early intervention/prevention work. Responsibility of looking after the Juvenile Custody Centre in Bangor and have a bail support foster family located in Armagh Area.</p> <p>Stephen (SHSCT): Community Access Team works with 12-17 yrs, but referrals have to come through social workers. Working in partnership with EA and Barnardo's to offer social opportunities to young people with additional needs or disabilities. Clubs running in Armagh, Brownlow & Dromore which the Team are happy to help young people transition into. Also run bespoke programmes throughout the year.</p>
