The Hub had an agreement in place with Bolster who work with families open to Children with Disability Social Workers and able to take five referrals a month from January up until the end of March. It was hoped that PACT would continue to take referrals after that, but PACT now closed. Repeat referrals received more regularly so important for referral agencies to ask families if they have been directed previously to the FSH. Continuing to receive requests for financial help with oil & electricity which the Hub does not have access to, so they signpost accordingly.
