<b>FSH Update</b> <i>Provided via e-mail</i>	Caroline ( <b>Bolster Community / FSH</b> ): Recent number of referrals for Bereavement Support. Poor maternal mental health is a recurring factor in referrals. Families struggling with physical/risk taking behaviours, sleep, PICA, school avoidance for children with or awaiting a diagnosis for Autism/ADHD. Support for families with adolescents, conflict, breakdown in communication, arguments over screen time, lack of interest in school and future. Number of families already receiving support from Women's Aid.

Need for self-care &amp; resilience programmes in schools.</p> <p>Annie (<b>SHSCT</b>): Attended yesterday's EVAWG Conference in Newry. NMandDD Council aiming to take the lead. Sexualised language used by boys/young men in youth centres has been raised. Aoife McComiskey is the new DEA Co-ordinator for South Armagh and will attend the next LPG meeting.
